

Notable Rules for Paracanoe:

- 1- National Federations are permitted two entries in each Paracanoe events
- 2- Athletes are only permitted to race in the class in which they are classified; ie. KL1 athlete can only race in KL1
- 3- Sprayskirts/Spraydecks are not permitted for Paracanoe classification or Paracanoe races unless approved by the Chief official
- 4- Kayaks are only permitted to have one rudder under the hull. Hence, skegs and/or projecting keels are not permitted
- 5- Boat Dimensions & Weight (ICF Paracanoe Competition Rules–Section 7.2)

Remarks

* Nationals of Brazil, Republic of Korea and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil, Republic of Korea and Peru.

** If such nationals enter the Kingdom at the immigration checkpoints which border neighboring countries, they will be allowed to stay for 15 days each

Italy and Japan, whose granted period of stay will not exceed 30 days each time. In addition, such nationals who hold diplomatic and official passports are also practically exempted from visa for tourism.

• ***Insurance:***

All Individuals Jury, Team Officials & Participants are required to possess health and travel insurance.

• ***Accreditation:***

All Individuals Jury, Team Officials & Participants are requested to email a passport size photograph with Final Entry Forms.

• ***Uniform***

All members of the same crew shall compete with the same uniform clothing and in the official uniform of their respective National Federation.

• ***Medical care***

The following medical services are available for all official participants of the above event: physician on duty, hospital and clinic assistance. A medical Centre will operate at the regatta course with ambulance and first aid. All costs above the regular care to be covered by the medical insurance policy
